About IR-MULTILING

- Two year research project aiming to offer an understanding of national landscapes with regards to industrial relations and the challenge of language
- Aiming to identify idiosyncratic variables relevant to the Member States under study: France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Spain, and UK
- The research will look at the social context; data and trends, e.g. migration; legislative and industrial relations landscape; actors, e.g. the role of trade unions, NGOs, employers, etc.







- Project teams in all countries will look into three case studies, e.g. in the UK we will look at food processing industry in Northern Ireland, cleaning companies in England and a construction company in London
- Case studies will involve interviews or focus groups with migrants who do not speak English

- International workshop and dissemination through our website, a DVD and a brochure
